

HEIMAN BASKETBALL CAMP

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

SUMMER 2020

GENERAL

* Rules and guidelines for this outdoor summer youth basketball camp are created and consistent with the guidelines laid out by the Center of Disease Control (CDC) and the Ohio Department of Health. (Updated June 16th, 2020)

Camp Size

- Camp must operate under maximum group size limitations at all times.
 - No more than 25 campers total at all times
 - No more than 5 counselors total at all times

Employee Policy

- Require employees to stay home if symptomatic*
- Employees must perform daily symptom assessment.

REGISTRATION

Refund Policy

- A full refund for camp due to these new rules and regulations will be issued anytime before June 24th, 2020.
- Anytime after June 24th, 2020, a partial refund will be issued for any camper already signed up who can no longer participate.
 - These partial refunds will be issued based on number of days between the first day of camp and the date the refunded was requested.

Registration Documents

- Every camper will be required to fill out and bring to camp new waiver release forms on the first day of camp. Any camper without these forms will not be allowed to participate in camp activities until these forms are filled out. The forms will be available online and emailed to participants prior to the first day of camp.
- Camp will ensure staff members are up-to-date in CPR and AED trainings, as required, and that staff follow CDC guidelines when administering.

* Per the CDC, symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headaches, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell

AT DROP-OFF

Temperature check

- Camp providers must check the temperatures of all staff and campers upon arrival. If any individual has a fever of 100 degrees or higher, they may not enter the facility.

Driveway

- Parents are asked to remain in their vehicle when dropping off their child to camp. If a question or concern needs to be addressed, please bring it to the attention of the camp providers from within the car and, if deemed necessary, the parent will be granted permission to exit the vehicle.
- Traffic will be halted on the road while cars enter and exit the property. To avoid long waits, drivers will enter, drop off camper and exit in a timely manner.

Masks

- Camp providers will be required to wear mask at pickup, drop-off, and enforced during any close contact with campers.
- Masks are not mandatory for the campers, but encouraged at the start of camp and if any parents wish to exit their vehicle to either speak with their child or speak with a camp provider.

DURING THE DAY

Hand-washing station

- Day camp workers and participants must follow rigorous hand washing procedures as detailed in Appendix B to Ohio Administrative Code 5101:2-12-13.
 - Upon arrival and after breaks.
 - After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
 - Before and after lunch
- Multiple hand washing stations will be set up in and around the property

Sanitation

- Shared equipment will be required to be sanitized throughout the day.
 - Before camp
 - After lunch
 - At the end of camp
- Equipment will include but not be limited to
 - Basketballs

- Food/cooking utensils
- Prizes and awards

Designated areas on the property

- Camp will have assigned areas in which campers will be allowed to congregate which will include
 - Camp Pavilion
 - Driveway
 - Basketball court
 - Grass area around basketball court
- Campers **WILL NOT** be allowed to congregate
 - At the pool
 - In the garage
 - In the house
 - Unless deemed necessary and under the guidance and permission from a camp counselor
- Each team will have a designated area in which any personal items will be placed while at camp. These bins will be separate from other team bins around the camp property.

Lunch

- Lunch will be served one team at a time, with rigorous hand washing before and after.
- Campers will remain separated by teams while eating
- Only one staff member, wearing proper gloves and masks, will handle the food during lunch time.

If any camper or camp worker develops a fever throughout the week

- Camp must immediately send home any child or employee who has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher. This individual may not return until they are fever free for 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medication. If the individual has had contact with someone confirmed or probable to have COVID-19, he or she must complete isolation or quarantine procedures in coordination with the local health department prior to returning to the program.

AT PICK-UP

Upon Arrival for Pickup

- Camp providers must ensure that children wash their hands prior to departure.

Driveway

- Please reference Drop-Off Driveway section as the same rules and regulations will apply for pick-up

RAIN DELAY

Rain Protocol

- The Heiman Camp WILL NOT be able to host at an indoor facility this summer.
- In the event of rain, the camp will do its best to wait out and dry up the outdoor court in order to create activities and games.
- If the conditions remain too unsafe to play, camp will be cancelled and/or rescheduled for the day.
 - Parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child once camp is cancelled for that day

Rain Out Refund Policy

- Refunds will not be issued due to rain unless more than 50% of the camp can not be rescheduled for the week.
- In the event that 50% or more of camp is canceled due to weather conditions, then refunds will begin to be issued based on the percentage of camp that took place as well as the expenses already allotted to host camp.
 - For example: If 50% of the camp is cancelled, then a 50% refund will be issued minus the allotted expenses. If the non-refundable expenses make up 60% of the camp, a total of 20% will be refunded back.
 - A more detailed breakdown of this policy is available by request and will be given if a majority of camp is cancelled due to weather.

FINAL GAMES/CAMP WRAP UP

Final Games

- In order to stay in compliance with the limited number of participants on the property at all time, The Heiman Basketball Camp WILL NOT be able to host the final games for camps this summer.
- The Final Games will take place at the end of the last day of camp.

Camp Wrap Up/Awards

- The awards ceremony will take place immediately after the final games.
- Parents will not be able to attend the awards ceremony. The awards will be distributed to each camper before the end of the last day of camp. Pick up will abide by the normal pick up procedures and camp will be over for that week.
